

Policy for Community Tables at the Market

The Tarrytown and Sleepy Hollow Farmers Market strives to create an inclusive environment where all members of the community feel welcome.

Nonprofit and volunteer organizations are welcome to request a “community table” stall at the market, as space permits, for the purpose of sharing information about their organizations and educating the community on topics that are complementary to the mission of the market.

Examples of educational topics and organizations that support and/or complement our mission include:

- Nutrition and food preparation
- Environment
- Sustainable gardening, lawn and plant care
- Sustainable living
- Health and wellness
- Conservation of natural resources, recycling, composting
- Local history
- The arts
- Local schools and athletics programs

Local government bodies may attend for the purpose of educating and informing residents of their services.

Raffles, sales and fundraising are discouraged.

Community tables are not intended for organizations to engage in any partisan or religious activities, solicitation or campaigning. This includes gathering signatures for candidates or ballot questions.

Our intention is to maintain the overall neighborly vibe that has become a hallmark of the TaSH.
